There were 16 responses, with many people submitting comments too, which provides a real depth of feedback. The Senior Leadership Team have reviewed the responses and outlined actions.



As a school, we believe that working closely with families is the best way to support children. We have an open-door policy, finding time to listen to the issues that matter to our parents. We would encourage parents and carers to contact class teachers in the first instance, to discuss their child's personal, social and academic needs. You can do this via Class Dojo.



"More art, cooking, outdoor education and trips should be organised. Get the children to grow veg and sell it. Teach them life skills! Also get access to forest schools. The school seems more focused on class base learning. Creative learning and outdoor Ed is great for the mind! My child likes being outdoors."



Significant investment has been made to ensure that the outdoor classroom is safe, including a new fenced area around the pond. Pathways have been cleared and further improvements are planned for later in the year. This is thanks to the enormous generosity of our PTA. Mr. Smout has scheduled outdoor learning lessons for all pupils. Beach school lessons continue. Two new cookers have been purchased which ensure that pupils can access opportunities for food technology lessons. The garden area contains a fruit and veg planter for each class to grow their own produce. We have a full school visits programme and regular visits and visitors to school.





2. My child feels safe at school ¹⁶ responses






3. The school makes sure pupils are well behaved 16 responses







7b. My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed. ² responses







Areas for development

You told us...

"He isn't a fan of school but I don't think he would be a fan of any other school more!"

"I feel there are too many children in the class. Children that are shy or struggling are getting left behind with their learning. Children that are excelling are bored. The learning seems to suits the children in the middle grounds. (I speak on behalf of other parent's views and my own - this has always been like this, as I had another child attend Hopton school)."

"There was an incident a couple of years ago where I was told my child was meeting all the targets and then, when I received his report, he was below expectations in most things."

"She's doing ok but it could be a lot better."

"We would like our child to be challenged, e.g. performing arts. We believe she excels when given a challenge and encourage she's amazing."

"The fences need to be higher along the main road. Is there an alarm for the school if a stranger/someone dangerous comes into the grounds? Lock down drills should be put in place."
