Home learning

- Home learning always comes out on a Wednesday.
- It needs to be handed in on a Monday.
- It includes- a piece of English (usually grammar or phonics related) from this week, last week and next
- A piece of maths from this week, last week and next
- Spellings from that week or phonics
- Squeebles times tables

Reading

- We would like you and your child to read every day if possible.
- 15 minutes each day is recommended
- Parents to fill in the reading record
- Reading records are checked every Monday and dojo points are given if your child has read at least three times.
- READING BOOKS AND RECORDS NEED TO BE IN SCHOOL EVERY DAY.

PE

- PE is taught on Monday and Wednesday/Thursday
- Please make sure children come into school in a full kit on these days.
- Plimsolls are recommended for use in the hall and trainers for outside.
- Please name everything- it sometimes makes things easier to find/return.

Contacting us

- Please feel free to grab us on the door in the morning or at the end of the day.
- If you need to have a longer or more private meeting just arrange it with us on the door.

Rewards

- Class dojo points are given out for good learning and behaviour which will get totalled together for class rewards.
- Children will also be collecting individual points which will accrue for certain rewards.
- 20 sticker from class teacher
- 40 15 minutes on an activity of their choice
- 60 visit from Miss Jo
- 80 Headteacher certificate
- 100 lunch with a child/adult of their choice
- 1000 class reward, children to choose
- Dojo points will be reset every half term

Consequences

- If they are not showing good learning behaviours they will be given a warning, 3 warnings will be given before any other action taken
- Behaviour of a more serious nature will be dealt with by a member of the senior leadership team as per the schools behaviour policy.
